<sup>3</sup>Georgia changed to a regional review process in FY 2007; data collected prior to that change were based on case samples pulled from selected counties; beginning FY 2007, case samples are pulled by region so that all counties are potentially included in the review process, with the exception of Fulton and DeKalb counties, which fall under the Kenny A Consent Decree review process for foster care cases.

Quarter 9 and 10 data for Fulton were for the review periods ending October 31, 2010, and January 31, 2011, respectively.

As of Jan 2009, Safety Items 1, 3 and 4 include Fulton and DeKalb counties; Kenny A outcome measures are being used for Permanency Items 7 and 10 for Fulton and DeKalb counties; targeted case reviews are being used for Well-Being Items 17-20 in Fulton County. Kenny A Outcome 27 is a six-month measure that includes a six-month look-back on case plan review that includes the permanency goal; Outcome 24 is an annual measure of high school/GED completion.
